

Q1 Will you have a scholar attending Leman Academy of Excellence for the 2022-2023 academic year?





Instead of Mrs. Bradley dealing with just those scholars, punishing their negative behavior, she will punish the whole class, Examples: assigning 20 pages of reading homework in one night; pulling all the scholars into the hallway 2-3 times in one class period to lecture the whole class...one would think she would reward the positive behaviors and punish the negative. (3) And the third issue, is the bullying that seems to happen in middle school. The bullying appears to be an on-going situation at Leman that doesn't get addressed (as my daughter was also bullied in middle school when she was there.) And it is the bullying that upsets me the most. For the first time in my son's academic career, he is NOT happy being in school. He is NOT enjoying school and he has asked if he could just skip 8th grade and go straight to LuHi. Academically, he probably could. However, I told him, 'No', he has to complete 8th grade. Kevin has been at Leman since 4th grade. He has been a 'high honor roll' student every single guarter. He has never been a problem scholar, nor has he ever gotten into trouble with his teachers. On the contrary, all his teachers have shared that he is a delight in class, a hard worker, polite, etc. It frustrates me to no end that my son no longer enjoys attending Leman. He is tired of the bullying, he is tired of extra work due to other's actions and he just wants to be done. This is one of the reasons I exempted Kevin from the CMAS. He has taken this test so many times, I know where he stands academically and the fact that he isn't enjoying school led to me to allow him to stay home. To sleep in, relax and not be in an environment inwhich he doesn't want to be in.

I was more disappointed in the teachers approach to problem solving this year then in past- it was a whole group punishment which I don't agree with

Q8 Please rate Leman Academy's general school communication:





The organization running it (whom we're assuming was paid A LOT of money) did not bring enough staff to run the practices or the reenactment and failed to provide a meaningful experience. Perhaps other organizations can be considered for future years? We were disappointed with Mr. Estes specifically. There were many days that he failed to teach a math lesson or assign any homework, he never communicated expectations clearly, he "rewarded" our scholar for good behavior with no math homework (lost learning), our scholar was not challenged by his teaching but did not qualify for the gifted program, and we had to supplement our scholar's learning the entire school year.
