 - Question – Are the building going to be connected? Dr. Edwards responded: Buildings not connected. Following CO regulations, all doors will be locked at all times. Planning on office member being at new building entrance to allow late drop off. Key card passes for scholars to move to one building to next for such things as nurse.
 - The only way to get into Phase 2 building will be key card.
