  - Math Growth Math curriculum's in comparison: In-to Math, Illustrative Mathematics, & Saxon
    - Saxon great for introduction of basics, spirals back to concepts, will keep curriculum for grades K-2, but for subsequent grades has been identified as difficult to assess any growth in modeling and reasoning. Also can only assess cumulative only. No Flexible skilled grouping for this age group.
    - In-to Math has great instruction and resources for teachers and parent support
      supplementation at home (digital videos, homework pdf, textbook), immediate feedback
      leads to targeted teaching, unitized approach provides a better opportunity for scholars to
      catch up if class or concept missed. Option for immediate feedback on assessments to be
      available for small group focus.
    - Illustrative Mathematics does well of differentiation may lead to better depth of thought discussion, perhaps best used as a supplement resource with In-to Math
