

LEMAN CLASSICAL SCHOOL QUARTERLY BOARD MEETING
TUESDAY, JULY 8, 2025 AT 6:00 P.M.
MINUTES

The LCS Board met via zoom for the LCS Quarterly Board Meeting on July 8, 2025. The meeting started at 6:01 pm. Paige McLaughlin presided, and a quorum was present with board members Victoria Hostin, and Stacy Thomas in attendance. Head of Schools, Dr. Jason Edwards was also present along with Alexa Goldkuhl, Director of Human Resources. Board Members, Hope Kentnor and Chris Young were not present.

Ms. McLaughlin made a motion to approve the May 23, 2025 Special Board Meeting minutes. Victoria seconded. A vote was taken. There was no opposition. The May 23, 2025 Special Board Meeting minutes were approved.

There were no public comments.

Ms. McLaughlin with the assistance of Ms. Goldkul and Dr. Edwards provided the LCS Board a first policy review for the 2025-2026 Employee Handbook that provided limited changes.

Ms. McLaughlin motioned to, due to exigent circumstances, accept the changes as presented and waive the second reading of the policy changes so that they are effective immediately. Ms. Thomas seconded. A vote was taken. There were no objections.

Ms. McLaughlin with the assistance of Dr. Edwards provided the LCS Board a first policy review for the 2025-2026 Family Handbook that provided limited changes.

Ms. McLaughlin motioned to, due to exigent circumstances, accept the changes as presented and waive the second reading of the policy changes so that they are effective immediately. Ms. Hostin seconded. A vote was taken. There were no objections.

Ms. McLaughlin provided an update regarding the LCS Governing Board Seat B - Hope Kentnor, who was not present for the meeting. Ms. Kentnor currently serves in a LCS

Board-Approved Seat which was formerly held by Barry Arrington. Ms. McLaughlin would suggest that if Ms. Kentnor is approved by the LCS Board to continue serving through the next term, to amend her term to be as follows: July 2025 - May 2028. This would allow for the seat's term to end when other terms end to facilitate easier renewal or elections within one board meeting.

Ms. McLaughlin made a motion to approve Hope Kentnor to continue her role as an LCS Board Member in Seat B, a Board-Approved Seat with an amendment to the seat term to end in May 2028. Ms. Hostin Seconded. There was no opposition. LCS Board Seat B will continue to be filled by Hope Kentnor with the amended term ending May 2028.

APPROVED: LCS Board Seat B will continue to be filled by Hope Kentnor with an amended term date ending May 2028.

Ms. McLaughlin then provided an LCS Board President Update including the status for final TCO on balance of the Bayou Gulch campus and finalization for the PTO funds being provided to the RVC itemized for the Stroh Campus.

Dr. Edwards then provided the Head of Schools update to the LCS Governing Board including current scholar enrollment, which as of the date of the meeting, was in line with the budgeted headcount of scholars. In addition, Dr. Edwards provided a Leadership Summit Meeting update planned for July 9, 2025. The nature of his update was for strategic planning in preparation for those participating in the first Leadership Summit.

Ms. McLaughlin made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:27 pm. Ms. Hostin Seconded. There was no opposition. Meeting adjourned at 6:27 pm
