What is a Spirit Rock?

A Spirit Rock is an opportunity to share exciting events with our school community by painting your own message. You can reserve the rocks for anything!! A student's birthday, thank a teacher or staff member, congratulatory events, good luck on competitions and tournaments, recognizing milestones. The rock is a fun way to spread any kind of positive message. Please note that profanity, political messages, and business advertisements are not permitted.

How can I reserve the rock(s)?

It's simple, just click on the link above and then the date(s) you want to reserve. Every calendar day is listed. You are welcome to rent on a weekend day or school holiday, but please pay attention to the school calendar if you prefer to rent on a school day.

You may begin painting at 4 pm on the day prior to your reservation. So if you reserve September 10, you can begin painting on September 9 at 4 pm. Please respect the family before you and do not paint earlier than 4 pm. If weather or something else prevents you from painting the night before, you can paint during the school day if you are extra careful about paint overspray and nearby parked cars.



Your 24-hour rental starts at 4:00pm the day prior to your rental. For example, if your child's birthday is August 15th, reserve August 15th and you may begin painting AFTER 4:00pm on August 14th.

RULES:

- ▶ Payment due at time of reservation.
- ▶ Paint ONLY the side that faces the school.
- ▶ Use a drop cloth to protect the surrounding gravel.
- ▶ Paint a rock free for a teacher's birthday!
- ▶ Begin painting no earlier than 4pm the day before.
- ▶ Have FUN!

You may not rent the rock for the same scholar for more than 24 hours, as it prevents other families from purchasing the rock for their scholar.

What supplies do I need?

Plan on using 1-2 cans of spray paint for the base coat and then additional paint for the design. You will need to bring drop cloths or garbage bags to protect the ground from overspray and may also want to bring painters tape, scissors, templates, or brushes to aid in the design as well. Please make sure that any nearby cars will not be hit by overspray!!!

ONLY the Rock may be painted. DO NOT paint the sidewalk or the landscape rocks or any other material surrounding the Rock. The individual or group will be held financially responsible for cleaning and/or repair costs associated with violation of this policy. Anyone painting the Rock must leave the area in clean condition. Remove all paint materials and litter from the site and be sure the paint is disposed of properly off-campus.

ONLY the side of the rock facing the school may be painted. We love the designs that have been done front and back but it makes more work for the person painting after you to have to buy extra paint to cover your design.

The individual or group painting the rock assumes liability for any individual or member of the group who may be injured and/or incur clothing or other personal property damage. Please be kind to our environment and recycle empty paint cans, etc.
